We are seeking applicants to participate in the 2017 Coverts Training Workshop. This project is made possible with funding from USDA-NRCS, RI DEM, and URI.

The **RI Coverts Project** is a training program designed to help forest landowners manage their land for young forest habitat using sound forest management practices that can help restore wildlife populations. *Coverts* or thickets are patches of young forest or shrublands created for wildlife through forest management. This annual event has trained over a hundred landowners from across the state through its two and one-half day workshop that focuses on forest and wildlife management practices that benefit species needing young forest habitats and shrub thickets., .
